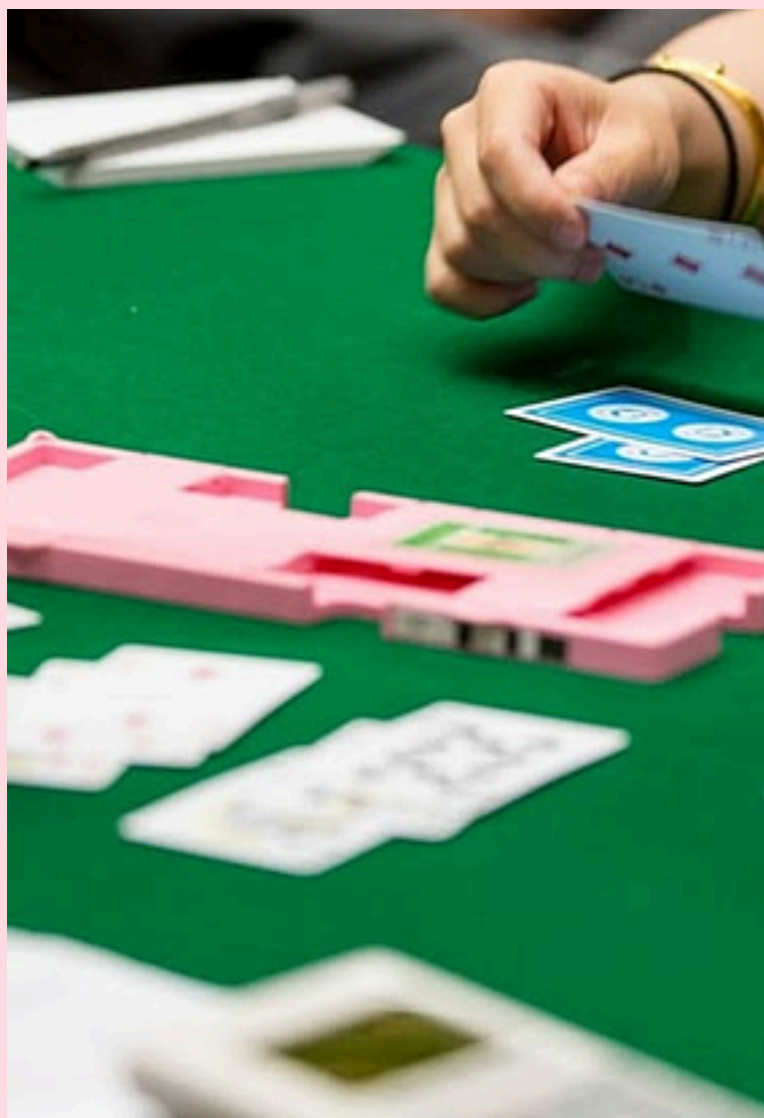

Maximum number of players per team: 6 per non-youth or school team, 8 per youth or school team

Corporate: Must be legal entities registered w/ROS or ACRA, or IHLs, Govt Ministries/ Stat Boards, or approved by SCBA

Youth: Must be 25 or younger on December 31 of the year of the competition.

Masters: Born in the year of 1971 or earlier (i.e. 55 years or older as of year of competition)

International: Can register under Open/Youth/School category at same rates.

Q&A (Updated on 20/4)

Registration

Is there a registration deadline? Can I do walk-in for the pair events?

- For the pair events, walk-ins are allowed. However, we strongly encourage you to register online to secure your place.
- Online registration for Team events ends on 9 July 2026 as we need time for preparation.
- As registration fees are collected by SportSG and they are not able to entertain any refunds, we advise you to make payment on SportSG's Pesta Sukan website only if you are very sure that you will be participating. Otherwise, we encourage making payment only after you have officially enrolled in the event at the venue.
- Indemification may be required - note that this is practiced across all events in the Pesta Sukan period and is not limited to Bridge only.

Which category am I eligible for?

- For Standard and Masters category, all teams and pairs must comprise of least 50% Singaporeans or Permanent Residents (PR). In addition, for Masters, all players must be born in the year of 1971 or earlier (i.e. 55 years or older as of year of competition).
- For Corporate, players must come from legal entities registered with ROS or ACRA, or IHLs, Government Ministries and Statutory Boards, or a group approved by SCBA. A full team of students will play under the Youth or School category instead of the Corporate category.
- A full, Masters age-eligible pair/team representing the Corporate category will pay the Masters rates instead of the Corporate rate.
- For Youth, all participants must be 25 or younger on December 31 of the year of the competition. **Students studying under universities are to register under this category.**
- For School, students come from a legally registered educational institution below university level, such as Secondary Schools, Junior Colleges or Polytechnics.
- International Teams are to register under Standard/Youth/School categories at the said rates. They are eligible for medals but not cash from SportSG since cash is reserved for Singaporeans. **However, SCBA has set up a separate prize pool, which they are eligible for a share.**

Can I use my ActiveSG Credits to pay for my registration?

- Unfortunately, SportSG has confirmed that ActiveSG Credits cannot be used.
- Please pay for our events by card/PayNow/Google Pay, and use your Credits for other eligible activities listed in the ActiveSG portal.

Play and Awards

Given that this event is co-organised, will it be Sport Singapore or SCBA running Pesta Sukan for Bridge?

- SCBA will continue to run the Pesta Sukan Bridge events on the ground.

How will Open Teams be run?

- For Open Teams Swiss, everyone will play in a single field.
- Each category will have their separate finals (Open / Masters / Corporate / Youth / School).
- The Top 4 Teams will be automatically enrolled in the Open Finals with the best prize pool, **even if they are international participants or belong to another category**. This means that the next teams down the line in the other category will compete for their category finals. However, such teams could exercise the option to play in the Finals of their own category instead, bumping the next team(s) up to the Open Final bracket.

What about all pair events?

- Everyone will also play in a single field.
- Inter Club Socials will be run in a Swiss Pairs format if possible.
- Open Pairs will be barometer if possible.
- All pairs are open for Open-level prizes and medals. For Mixed and Open Pairs, top-performing local pairs are also eligible for cash prizes from SportSG.

What happens if a category is lacking pairs or teams?

- While still being able to participate in the Open Field, the team will win the category by default.

Is the event vugraphed and will there be a bulletin?

- There will be vugraph for the Open Teams, along with a daily bulletin.

Location

Is there air con in Bishan Clubhouse Sports Centre?

- Yes, this venue offers full air-con.
- There will also be a room for vugraph viewing and resting at an upper level.

What modes of transportation are available to the Hall?

- The Hall is a 8-minute walk from Bishan MRT. For those travelling by car, there are many parking lots within the sports complex.

What nearby food options do I have?

There is a Thai and a Western restaurant within the complex. Otherwise, there are coffee shops close to Bishan MRT, and Junction 8 Mall itself.
